**2. Announcements, upcoming meetings, project updates, and general housekeeping**

**3. Approval of minutes for April 2018 regular meeting**

**4. SF Beautiful**

- Jim Phillips, Development Manager with SF Beautiful, presented on the organization and current projects.

## **5. SFMTA Capital Improvement Plan**

- Charlotte Wu, Capital Finance Team SFMTA, and Chad Rathmann, Sustainable Streets SFMTA, presented the Capital Improvement Plan and street projects (see presentation).
- Robin – Folsom Street bicycle lane is not safe or timed properly for bicycles. If you are going to make the city a first class bicycle city then we need infrastructure.
- Jason – Octavia to Buchanan cycle track is too narrow. There is a missing bicycle link between Valencia and Van Ness. Need to accommodate all of the incoming residents.
- Paul – Support raised crosswalks.
- Robin – existing bike parking is not adequate since scooters and bike share are taking up existing spaces.
- Krute – funding for education and outreach before the project is complete.

## **6. SOMA Freeway Ramp Intersections Study 2**

- Colin Dentel-Post, SFCTA, presented the SOMA Freeway Ramp Intersections Study 2 project (see presentation).
- Jason and Robin – we support taking down the Central Freeway. We would like to see the study to remove the freeway conducted. Cue drivers with design to slow down.
- Robin – streets adjacent to freeways are designed like freeways. Mid-block crossing between 13<sup>th</sup> Street and South Van Ness on Mission.
- Jason – uphill cycle track along Division. Use the side street adjacent to Discount Builders.
- Krute – improve visibility for drivers coming off 101 off-ramp onto 13<sup>th</sup> Street at Mission.
