The Upper Market Corridor, bounded by Octavia Boulevard and Castro Street, is the focus of the workshop series and design plan. The goal of the plan is to harness the potential of incoming development to enhance the public realm and visual character of the neighborhood, resulting in recommendations towards neighborhood identity, infill opportunities, and improvements to the public realm.

The final meeting will be an opportunity for community members to affirm the community design framework that was created during the first two community meetings. The meeting will also include activities that will address how the public space recommendations and new development guidelines of the design strategy should be applied to the Upper Market Street Corridor.
