



Quick-build project

- Near-term safety changes at the southwest corner of the intersection, inspired by the near-term concept
- Could be included in the quick-build:
 - Transit travel time improvements on eastbound Ocean Ave
 - Safety changes for walking/biking on Frida Kahlo Way
- Project expected to begin in early 2022, when funding and staffing become available
- Staff will present an updated design proposal at a public forum for feedback
